The treasurer's report submitted by Monica Evans reflected a balance of \$8466.74 as of July 2, 2011.

Sheila Brown, Fundraising chair, reported that Casino trip has sold out and that an announcement will go out on the Wine Tasting and Auction to be held on September 30th. All proceeds from the ticket sales would go to the HCCA. The board approved the motion for \$200.00 down payment on the rental fee for the use of St Timothy's Church.

Scott Akers reported that there were no new members signed up at the annual garden tour. There was a brief discussion on the use of the recreation center hours on Sundays. David Kirkpatrick reported that there would be no realignment of PSA606. National Night Out will be held on August 2nd at the East Washington Heights Baptist Church.
