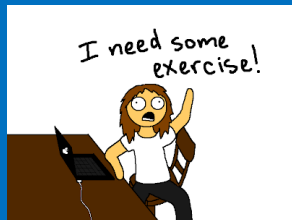

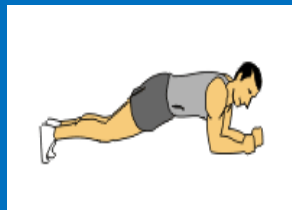


The DC Office on aging develops and carries out a comprehensive and coordinated system of health education, employment, and social services for the District's elderly population who are 60 years or older.
